# Shodhganga Repository: A Comparative Study with Special Reference to the Universities of Assam

### Abstract

Gives a clear picture about ETD repositories of India. Provides the basic information about the Shodhganga repository. Attempts to find out the status of universities of Assam registered in Shodhganga. On basis of this, the paper presents a comparative study among the universities of Assam about their status and contribution to Shodhganga. Concludes that Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETDs) are a positive development in graduate education, allowing broader exposure of graduate student research and opportunities for new forms of creative scholarship.

Keywords: Institutional Repository, Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETD), Shodhganga

### 1. Introduction

The revolution in the IT sector is influencing the information industry and has revolutionized the concept of libraries where it has been used extensively to record, store and disseminate the information in the digital form. Each and every library, stepby-step, shifts over to this dimension to meet the demand put on it. And to fulfill the demands of the users, a new concept "Institutional Repository (IR)" is developed. An IR is nothing but a digital archive of intellectual works of an institute particularly a research institute. The repositories are categories according to the type of content archived such as e-journals, e-theses, datasets, books, multimedia, etc. Theses and dissertations are often recognized as the only source for research work. The printed and hard copies are converted into digital form and put them in databases to retrieve them for the benefit of the research scholars. Due to the various benefits of ETDs, they are gaining importance over the traditional print format as a result in India University Grant commission took an initiative for developing common repositories for the theses collection alone which brought the born of the Shodhganga repository.

### 2. Aims and Objectives

The basic aims and objectives of the study are:

- To give a clear picture about ETD repositories of India,
- To provide the basic information about the Shodhganga repository,
- To find out the status of universities of Assam registered in Shodhganga, and
- To make a comparative study among the universities of Assam about their status and contribution to Shodhganga.

### 3. ETD Repositories in India

The Online Dictionary of Library and Information Science has defined electronic theses and dissertations (ETDs) as "The master's theses and PhD dissertations submitted in digital form rather in print

A recent study reveals that Central Library IIT, Bombay initiated ETD project in 1999 for the first time in India followed by Vidyanidhi at Mysore University in the year 2000 and so on. The information on ETD repositories in the world has mainly been collected from the Registry of Open Access Repositories (ROAR) and the Directory of Open Access Repositories (open DOAR). From the study, it has been found that out of 245 E-theses repositories across the world, the number from India is 25 which are registered under ROAR and Open DOAR respectively.

### 4. Shodhganga-At A Glance

The UGC Notification (Minimum Standards & Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree, Regulation, 2009) dated 1st June 2009 mandates submission of electronic version of theses and dissertations by the researchers in universities with an aim to facilitate open access to Indian theses and dis-

sertations to the academic community world-wide. Online availability of electronic theses through centrally-maintained digital repositories, not only ensure easy access and archiving of Indian doctoral theses but will also help in raising the standard and quality of research. This would overcome serious problem of duplication of research and poor quality

resulting from the "poor visibility" and the "unseen" factor in research output. As per the regulation, the responsibility of hosting, maintaining and making the digital repository of Indian Electronic Theses and Dissertation (called "Shodhganga"), accessible to all institutions and universities, is assigned to the INFLIBNET Centre.



"Shodhganga" is the name coined to denote digital repository of Indian Electronic Theses and Dissertations set-up by the INFLIBNET Centre. The word "Shodh" originates from Sanskrit and stands for research and discovery. The "Ganga" is the holiest, largest and longest of all rivers in Indian subcontinent. The Ganga is the symbol of India's age-long culture and civilization, ever-changing, ever-flowing, ever-loved and revered by its people, and has held India's heart captive and drawn uncounted millions to her banks since the dawn of history. Shodhganga stands for the reservoir of Indian intellectual output stored in a repository hosted and maintained by the INFLIBNET Centre.

The Shodhganga@INFLIBNET is set-up using open source digital repository software called DSpace developed by MIT (Massachusetts Institute of Technology) in partnership between Hewlett-Packard (HP). The DSpace uses internationally recognized protocols and interoperability standards. Shodhganga provides a platform for research scholars to deposit their Ph.D. theses and make it avail-

able to the entire scholarly community in open access. The repository has the ability to capture, index, store, disseminate and preserve ETDs (Electronic Theses and Dissertations) submitted by the researchers.

DSpace supports "Open Archives Initiative's Protocol for Metadata Harvesting" (OAI-PMH) and uses a qualified version of the Dublin Core schema for its metadata. The INFLIBNET Centre promotes setting-up of institutional and ETD repositories in member universities using OAI-PMH complaint software. A number of member universities have already set-up their institutional and ETD repositories using either DSpace or other OAI-PMH compliant Institutional Repository software. It would be possible for universities having sufficient network and computing infrastructure to maintain their own ETD repositories wherein their research scholars could deposit e-version of their theses and dissertations. Moreover, they can use Shodhganga to host their theses as backup archives. INFLIBNET Centre, besides maintaining the Central ETD Repository (Shodhganga) would also deploy a central server to harvest the Metadata from all such ETD repositories distributed in universities with an aim to provided unified access to theses and dissertations through its harvesting server. Shodhganga receives e-India Jury Choice Award for the year 2011 under Digital Learning Category.

The list of Universities that contributed in Shodhganga is attached as **Appendix 1.** 

### 4.1 Features of Shodhganga

Shodhganga provides simple search and advanced search option to access theses. It also includes the browsing options like community/collection, authors, title, subjects and date. The repository contains any useful links and highlighting a list of recent submission and links to other ETD services of

India. It provides step by step submission of theses. The repository has also incorporated with Web 2.0 applications such as RSS feeds.

# **4.2** Creation of Metadata and Uploading Thesis into Shodhganga

INFLIBNET, to maintain Shodhganga, has established a central server to harvest the metadata from all ETD repositories located in universities. It aims to provide unified access to theses through its harvesting server. The repository permits the submitter to create metadata for his/her thesis.

INFLIBNET Centre has simplified the submission process with one-page one-form submission with almost all mandatory fields. While some of the fields can be selected from drop down box and other field should be filled with care. For example, in Title text box, first letter is in capital and all other letters are in small case except proper nouns.[ Show All Universities ]

### 5. Benefits of Joining in Shodhganga

The UGC vide its Notification (Minimum Standards & Procedure for Award of .Phil. / Ph.D Degree, Regulation, 2009) dated 1st June 2009 (Appendix-I) provides for submission of electronic version of theses and dissertation by the researchers in universities in Shodhganga maintained by the INFLIBNET Centre. Universities that sign MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre and mandate submission of electronic version of their theses and dissertation to Shodhganga may get financial assistance from the UGC for digitizing their back-files of theses. Besides, UGC may also provide financial assistance to the INFLIBNET Centre for subscription to software tools that detect plagiarized portion of theses and dissertations. Access to software designed to detect plagiarism will be provided to universities that sign MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre for Shodhganga.

In times to come, ETDs would become more commonplace, grant-giving agencies and accreditation bodies like AICTE, UGC and NAAC would make judgments regarding innovative universities by taking note of their initiatives such as ETDs and IRs.

Furthermore, plagiarism is a major concern in the area of research which results in the poor quality of research. Proper software tools are now available to detect and deter plagiarism. The increased visibility of theses and dissertations through open access repositories would further act as a deterrent to plagiarism. Moreover, it will attract other organizations in India and abroad to collaborate with Indian universities on topics of mutual interests. Besides, availability of formidable number of theses through a single repository would facilitate the INFLIBNET Centre to launch alerting and analytical services deploying data mining and other technology tools.

# 6. Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) for SHODHGANGA

Universities are required to sign a MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre to participate in the Shodhganga project. This MoU spells out the responsibilities of Universities and INFLIBNET Centre related to Shodhganga. Based on the agreement, INFLIBNET Centre would recommend to UGC for the release of Grants earmarked for the Shodhganga project during XI Plan Period.

Based on this, State-wise distribution of universities that signed MoU in Shodhganga are attached as Appendix 2

# 7. Contribution Of Universities Of Assam To Shodhganga

In the entire north-eastern region of India, universities in the state of Assam are considered to be the most productive and leading institutions of higher education. Assam is a multicultural state and its uni-

versities play the pioneering role of visualizing its diverse tradition. With excellent faculty and administration, the state universities generate a learning ambiance for the aspirants all across the country.

There are a total of sixteen universities in Assam including two Central Universities and three private universities.


From the Table 2, it is clear that among the 16 universities of Assam, there are only 6 universities where research work has not yet started. The Table also shows that Assam Down Town University and Assam Don Bosco University are those private universities where research work is going on. But the important point that can been noticed from the Table is that though ten universities of Assam have been carrying out the research work still only three universities have been registered in Shodhganga. These universities are Gauhati University (GU), Gauhati; Assam University (AU), Silchar; and Tezpur University (TU), Tezpur.

# 7.1 Status of GU, TU, AU in Shodhganga: A comparative study

The Table 3 shows that GU has the highest numbers of departments and it is the GU that has been submitted highest number of theses (59) in Shodhganga, whereas though TU has the lowest number of departments, yet almost 50% departments have been registered in Shodhganga which is a good sign. In case of AU, it has thirty five departments but only sixteen departments have been registered in Shodhganga and 36 theses have been submitted. From this Table, it is clear that most of the departments of GU and AU are not registered with Shodhganga in comparison to TU.





From the Tables 4 to 6 and the Figures 2 to 4, it is clear that seventeen numbers of departments under GU, sixteen numbers of departments under AU and nine numbers of departments under TU have been registered in Shodhganga. Again, from the seven-

teen of departments under GU, 59 theses; sixteen departments under AU, 36 theses; and nine departments under TU, 16 theses have been submitted in Shodhganga,

The Tables and Figures also show that under GU, the Mathematics department has submitted the highest numbers of theses (8), and in case of AU and TU, the departments that have submitted highest number of theses in Shodhganga are Ecology & Environmental Science and Mathematical Science respectively. It is also clear from the Tables that maximum numbers of departments under all the three universities have submitted only one or two theses in Shodhganga.

### 8. Findings

From the study, it is clear that The Shodhganga@INFLIBNET Centre provides a platform for research students to deposit their Ph.D. theses and make it available to the entire scholarly community in open access. The repository has the ability to capture, index, store, disseminate and preserve ETDs submitted by the researchers. From the study, it is also clear that Shodhganga is helping to avoid duplication of research work, ensuring quick retrieval of information, and providing a permanent solution of the space.

The study also reveals that a total number of 162 universities all over India are contributing in Shodhganga by submitting their research work and out of these universities, JNU, New Delhi occupies the top rank by submitting the highest number of theses. (**Appendix 1**)

Though Assam has sixteen universities, but only three universities have been registered in Shodhganga and this can be easily seen from the Table 1. The reason behind this situation is still unknown. It may be due to lack of interest of the uni-

versities/ departments or lack of awareness of the research scholars / guides.

The Tables 3, 4, 5 & 6 also show an unsatisfactory picture of the three surveyed universities. Though GU is the oldest university of Assam, having the highest numbers of departments, yet the contribution is not enough. Likewise, the other two universities which are the only central universities of Assam are also not so much interested in submitting their theses to Shodhganga, though Shodhganga provides an unique platform for the etheses.

### 9. Suggestions

Some suggestions regarding the study has been put forwarded which are latest but not the least.

- ETD is a new generation of theses and dissertations that can include colour diagrams, colour images, hypertext link audio, video, animation etc. Shodhganga should take initiative in this regard.
- ETD awareness programme- promotional activities provide understanding of the issues and options and can encourage cooperation among institutions that are planning or have implemented ETD programmes.
- More workshops and training programmes for for both students and faculty need to be conducted on issues of copyright, choices of access by INFLIBNET, which will encourage the researchers to submit their theses online.
- The institutional library professionals should also concern about Shodhganga and other ETD projects. They can give a lecture to the faculties / students about the needs of e-theses and thus they can create awareness among the users about Shodhganga.
- Articles/ Seminar papers regarding Shodhganga should be published in various

media and the discussion should be made among the readers so that they will be aware, interested and become knowledgeable.

#### 10. Conclusion

ETD, i.e., Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETDs) are a positive development in graduate education, allowing broader exposure of graduate student research and opportunities for new forms of creative scholarship. A number of universities have now begun to accept electronic submission of theses and dissertations and then post these documents on library web servers. ETD repositories are becoming a major resource for information in all subjects. The theses and dissertations submitted by the research scholars to a particular university in print form are meant only for the university communities and not for the others. But ETD repositories are going to solve this problem by making the institutional knowledge available by being an online knowledge hub. Shodhganga, the most efficient repository in Indian context provides the platform to deposit the theses in electronic version and make it available to the entire scholarly communication in open access. Universities, whether it is state, central or private should contribute their knowledge, i.e., their valuable research work to Shodhganga so that these will create a path of information and knowledge to all the scholarly communities irrespective of sex, religion and age and we the library professionals have to take initiatives to create access and awareness of ETDs to user community.
