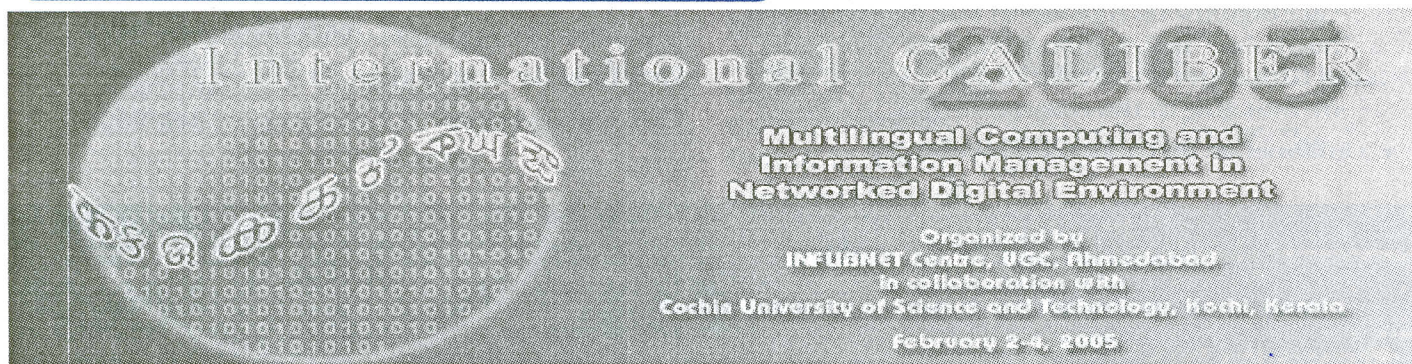

Every year INFIBNET Organises an international convention called CALIBER (Convention on Automation of Libraries in Education and Research Institutions) in collaboration with different Indian universities. This is the premier convention in India which provides a unique forum to the library and information professionals, teachers, IT professionals, consultants and users involved in automation and networking of libraries as well as information providers to come together and interact on the subjects of mutual interest.

The twelfth CALIBER in the series, for the year 2005, has been themed as

“Multilingual Computing and Information Management in Networked Digital Environment”

and will be hosted by Cochin University of Science and Technology, Kochi, Kerala during February 2-4, 2005.

The official language of the convention will be English.

consideration for publication elsewhere and the author should agree to transfer the copyright to the conference organisers. A passport size photograph(s) of author(s) has to be submitted with the paper. E-Subscription: News

1. E-Resource Training held at INFLIBNET

The 5th course on E-resource management using UGC-Infonet was organized by INFLIBNET during 17-21, May 2004. The programme was inaugurated by Prof. Dayanand Dongaonkar, Secretary General, Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Dongaonkar emphasized the importance of access to all literature from all scholars whether from private or UGC funded institutions. He lauded the initiatives of UGC and the role of INFLIBNET in enhancing higher education in the country. Director, INFLIBNET highlighted the activities of the centre and spoke about the new initiatives. 16 sessions were held during the course with one external faculty. The hands on was given

for accessing the resources. 15 participants participated in the programme.

The 6th course on E-resource management using UGC-Infonet was organized by INFLIBNET during 12-16, July 2004. The course was inaugurated by Prof. M N Desai, former Vice Chancellor, Gujarat University. In his inaugural address he appreciated the efforts of UGC-Infonet for providing scholarly access and urged the librarians to take the maximum benefit and meet the individual requirements of academicians. Dr. T A V Murthy, Director, INFLIBNET, in his presidential remarks highlighted the importance of UGC Infonet initiated by the Chairman UGC and role of INFLIBNET in enhancing the higher education system in India. During the five days course, 16 lectures were arranged of which 2 lectures were handled by invited resource persons and few presentations by the

publishers viz. Cambridge, Elsevier Science and the remaining sessions were handled by the faculty members from INFLIBNET. These Lectures mainly focused on aspects relating to implementation of UGC Infonet and related to the network management and E-resources covered under the programme. Besides the lectures, there were the demos / practical sessions on setting LAN, network security, Mail server, webserver, Access to Chemical Abstracts, Access to Biological Abstracts, Access to gateway portals, Access to Cambridge, Elsevier Science and other titles, digital library software using greenstone, web designing etc. Participants expressed that the research and academic community will be thrilled with this initiative and they were deprived till now of these resources. 19 participants attended the programme and took the benefit.

2. One - Day User Awareness training programmes held:

Awareness is very important for success of E-Subscription initiative. Nineteen One-Day User Awareness Programmes for using E-Resources under UGC Infonet Faculty members, Research Scholars and Librarians were conducted in the following Universities during April-May 2004 as per the following schedule.

User awareness training programmes at 65 more universities

The success of UGC-Infonet initiative depends on the actual usage of these resources. This calls for user education and faculty and research scholars and students need to be trained in using these electronic resources. The statistics of usage by the academicians across the country is very encouraging and this need further enhances through more and more awareness programmes. INFUBNET Centre has already conducted these awareness training programmes at 35 universities and will continue to have such programmes over the next two months. In order to ensure better access to scholarly resources subscribed under UGC-Infonet 65 such programmes will be conducted.

3. STN Training

INFUBNET Centre has been making its best effort through UGC-Infonet E-Journals Programme to provide access to electronic journals in all areas of learning. These resources are accessed by individual universities based on the IP address range supplied by them. It was observed that access to Chemical Abstracts is essential for Faculty and Research Scholars in the area of Chemistry. Though the access to chemical abstracts is very expensive, through UGC-Infonet E-Journals consortium this is being made available to all universities who are in need to access Chemical Abstracts. As per the recommendations of the National Negotiation Committee 10 universities have already been given the access to Chemical Abstracts through Sci-Finder. Though this facility will be expensive, but the access through Sci-finder is essential, as it is expected that the usage in these 10 universities would be very high. On the other hand, all other universities have been provided this access through STN. There is only difference, through Sci-finder the access will be 24 hours with one login at a time, however the access through STN is pay per view and 5 persons can simultaneously access the data based on pay per view facility. Hence access will be based on **"Pay Per View"**, and the entire payment will be made by INFUBNET for accessing the Chemical Abstracts. Each university has been provided with 5 login and passwords to access the same and training has been organized at nine places during the period. These programmes were coordinated by Dr. V S Cholin at Ahmedabad, Dr. P V Konnur at Goa University, Dr. Lalitha Jayaraman, at Anna University, Chennai, Dr. M D Baby, at Cochin University of Science and Technology, Cochin, Dr. Suresh Jindal, at University of Delhi, Dr. M Ishwar Bhat, at BITS, Pilani, Ms. Nalini Raja at University of Mumbai,. The second programme at Ahmedabad was organized by Dr. V S Cholin during July 2004. All these programmes were

conducted successfully by Mr. Makrand Waikar and Ms. Jyoti Singh of Sci-edge Information, Pune. The Director, INFUBNET, Dr. T AV Murthy, thanked all the coordinators for their full support in successfully conducting these specialized programmes.

National Seminar on Access to E-resources under UGC-Infonet –E-Journals Consortium

UGC-Infonet E-Journals consortium initiative taken by the Chairman University Grants Commission (UGC) is to facilitate free access to scholarly journals and databases in all areas of learning to the research and academic community across the country. The programme has been dedicated to the nation by His Excellency the President of India, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam on 28th December 2003 from Vigyan Bhavan during the concluding of Golden Jubilee celebrations of University Grants Commission. More than 2000 scholarly journals and databases are already made available for access which will cross 4000 journals in next few months. This effort has started making very good impact on the research and academic community and very encouraging usage is noticed. However, awareness is the key to exploit and utilize this scholarly literature in better way. There is a need to inform all the faculty, research scholars, students and library professionals to understand the

benefit of this programme in the light of huge resources made available first time in the country for higher education sector. In order to facilitate the research and academic community the access to scholarly resources, it is proposed to conduct two days national seminar at five different places across the country for taking the benefit by attending the programme nearby. These seminars are organized with an aim to:

1. To inform the users about the UGC-Infonet initiatives.
2. To inform number of features for scholars viz. article alerts, TOC alerts etc.
3. To spread awareness about the UGC-Infonet e-journals consortium and its resources.
4. To know the additional resources required for meeting the users expectations.
5. To serve and strengthen the higher educational system of our country through more effective, efficient and systematic approach.
6. To provide a platform to discuss the important issues of UGC-Infonet e-journals consortium at national level.

How can I register?

Participants may look for their convenient date and place and put their choice of preference against the places in the registration form. INFIBNET will try its best to accommodate the participants in their first choice of preference, however once the number of participants exceed for one programme they may be asked to attend the programme at their second / third choice of preference. 5. E-Resources: Friendly to visually impaired too!!! - A Unique user of the electronic resources at INFLIBNET.

Under UGC-Infonet consortium INFLIBNET has subscribed online resources for the use of Research and Academic community of the country providing opportunity to access scholarly journals and databases. Shri Durlabbhai M Patel, born visually impaired working as a lecturer in Govt., Polytechnic, Ahmedabad and doing his Ph. D entitled "Historio – Political Readings of the Major fiction of Amitav Gosh" in English literature from Gujarat University, Ahmedabad is one among those who regularly visits the Centre to get the information for his research work.

He opines that E-Resources available in INFLIBNET is of very much helpful for his research work and got tremendous benefit out of these with the help and co-operation of INFLIBNET staff. He fondly remembers that he got many important articles to develop his research hypothesis. He expressed that if he get the information in print he has to get it scanned and has to listen the content of the literature with the help of a software called 'Jaws for Windows 5.0' a special software developed for the people, who are visually impaired.

Instead of that he is getting the scholarly literature directly in Electronic format under the UGC –Infonet E-journal consortium, taking it either in floppy or in CD takes it to the home and listens it in his PC with the help of 'Jaws for Windows software' by which he is saving his time and money. He says that the electronic information available in INFLIBNET is of high value as compared with print as well Braille counterpart and can get idea about latest developments in the arena of English Literature.

He owes his thanks to Dr. T A V Murthy, Director and other staff at INFLIBNET for their much needed assistance in getting the value information and urges the authority to make arrangement for installing the 'Jaws for Windows 5.0' software, by which he can directly listen the E-content and get the idea more easily.

KVS – INFLIBNET In-service Training Programme for School Librarians on Library Automation, Networking and E-Resources Management

Kendriya Vidyalaya's were established in the year 1963-64 starting with 20 schools and now they are 871 in number having enrolment of about 8 lakh students and more than 40,000 teachers. They are spread all over the country. Kendriya Vidyalayas were conceived and came into being as pacesetters. The recruitment of staff is a nation-wide affair with a high degree of choice for quality. A carefully conceived curriculum, a uniformly split-up syllabus, text-books and the teachers' guides prepared by the NCERT and the CBSE, updated teaching methods, well-planned co-curricular activities, games and sports, library service etc. all these and more are integral features of Kendriya Vidyalayas.

The Principal of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sanghatan, Gandhinagar had asked INFLIBNET Centre to conduct

the training programme for KVS School Librarians. The training programme was named as "KVS – INFUBNET In-Service Training Programme For School Librarians On Library Automation, Networking and E-Resources Management" with three weeks duration, specially designed for kendriya vidyalaya school Library professionals. Discussions were held with senior staff of KVS and INFUBNET technical staff for designing this kind of specialized course. The topics were selected keeping in view of the objectives of this programme, i.e., creating awareness about the most modern technologies and nurturing IT culture in KVS Librarians. The following are the broad topics selected in which specialized and comprehensive lectures were delivered and practicals were conducted;

Study tours to different Libraries, like Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad to understand the proper implementation of modern technologies, were also arranged for the participants. Projects and assignments were assigned to participants compulsorily, which had to be completed and presented using PowerPoint prior to the concluding session. In addition to the project, Pre-test and Post-tests were also conducted for participants to evaluate their awareness about the IT applications. 45 participants from different Regions across the country viz. Ahmedabad (6), Bangalore (3), Bhubaneswar (7), Chennai (5), Hyderabad (6), Kolkata (10), Mumbai (4) and Silchar (4) attended the training programme.

During the three weeks, 51 lectures were scheduled. Three lectures were handled by the external resource persons viz. Sh. Satish Deshpande and Sh. D R Kulkarni from British Council Library, Ahmedabad and Dr. S S Shirurmath, Librarian, Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad. Five lectures were handled by KVS faculty and remaining 44 lectures were taken by the INFUBNET faculty members.

During the training programme, lectures were organized in the morning sessions and afternoon sessions were meant for practical, so all the participants spent sufficient amount of time in the Computer Lab and each participant got one computer to practice.

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Library Profile

**Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS)
Pilani Library: An Infilbnet consortium member**

Hybrid library model

BITS Library has been making determined efforts to become a truly hybrid library wherein both electronic and paper based information sources are used alongside each other. The service delivery is done in a seamlessly integrated way. The hybrid library model at BITS has two aims: (i) To improve the delivery of library service in the campus by making use of both printed and electronic resources which compliment each other (ii) To provide information anytime anywhere. The Hybrid libraries recognize the importance of printed materials, and they make effective use of technology in order to improve the access to them. On the other hand, they realize the potential of the digital media and seize the opportunity in order to provide larger quantity of information to the users in a distributed information environment. The Hybrid library concept is very significant especially in BITS which is a specialized university offering both degree, postgraduate and research programmes in Sciences, Engineering and Humanities. While the undergraduates depend heavily on the printed materials, the postgraduates and researchers do the info-mining of electronic resources.

Campus wide Computer Network - NEURON (Next generation Enabled University wide Redundant Optical Network)

The institute has a state of the art completely switched, IPVC capable, voice enabled network. It is one of the largest network infrastructures among the educational institutions in the country. It supports 5000 data ports, and provides connectivity to each hostel room, staff houses, library building, instructional buildings, lecture halls, laboratories and guest house. It uses gigabit fiber optic back bone to provide 100 MBPS desktop connectivity at each data port. The institute network is connected to outside world using 4 MBPS shared Internet leased circuit. All students and staff members are provided with internet facility. The NEURON was completed in January, 2004. To coincide with the launch of NEURON, the BITS Library developed an information rich library portal which serves as the main library interface.

New Library Building

BITS got a new library building which was inaugurated on 19th March, 2004. With over 65000 sft floor area and 750 seating, this is one of the biggest and finest library buildings of recent times. A large part of the floor is marbled, the building has been

designed with a view to give palatial ambience and there is an abundance of place to walk around. The features include Dhoolpur stone pillars, Jharokas, Arches, Chandeliers, Rajasthani paintings and plenty of natural light. The high ceiling and skylights make it highly energy efficient and also provide the necessary insulation against the temperature extremities. The new library is a good blend of Rajasthani architecture, aesthetics and modern technology. Facilities in the library are: reading halls and stacks, toilets, e library, study carrels, meeting hall, audio visual room, and informal seating areas. The greenery both inside and outside the library provide the necessary soothing to the eyes. The library is located close to all academic blocks of the institute and has generator back up for power breakdowns. While cables are used for LAN, wireless internet is accessible and anyone can access the internet on his/her laptop in the library.

Computerization Programme

BITS library uses the Libsys library automation software on Linux platform. Almost 80% of the book records have been computerized. The books have been bar coded and all library routines have been automated. The library web OPAC is accessible on the library homepage and book reservations, enquiries etc can be done from the student rooms/ staff residences.

Support of UGC and INFLIBNET

UGC has been very supportive to BITS especially for library development. Apart from the grant of Rs 49 lakhs for the library building, UGC provided a non recurring grant of Rs 6.5 lakhs for library automation in 1999-2000 and thereafter it has been providing recurring grant of Rs 1.75 lakhs every year for library automation. BITS Library is a member of the Inflibnet consortium and getting access to more than 2000 electronic journals and the statistics show very high usage by the BITS faculty and students. Under UGC-Infonet BITS Pilani is supported with 512 KBPS additional bandwidth and the necessary hardware.

Library collection

The present collection is about 2,15,000 volumes which includes books and back volumes of journals. The collection is specialized in the area of Science and Technology,

Management and Pharmacy and Biological Sciences. However, there is an adequate collection of books on Literature, History and General reading. The library inherited the rich collections of the erstwhile Birla Colleges of Arts and Science which opened in Pilani in early 1930s. Therefore there is a good collection of rare and old books, back volumes (since 1920s) and manuscripts which have been carefully preserved.

Plans for the future

World of librarianship is fast changing and also are the requirements of library users. Both the library and the user habits are highly influenced by the technological advances which we have been witnessing especially during the past couple of decades. The library has to evolve continuously amidst the changing technological environment and also the user needs. Plans for BITS Library for the near future include : (i) Digitisation of rare books and manuscripts (ii) Increase the online content by creating digital files of old question papers, theses etc (iii) Providing remote access to the library resources for faculty and students posted in the various towns for practice school work (iv) Integration of printed and e resources and provide seamless search facilities (v) Conduct workshops and training programmes relevant to the librarians of the north-west states.

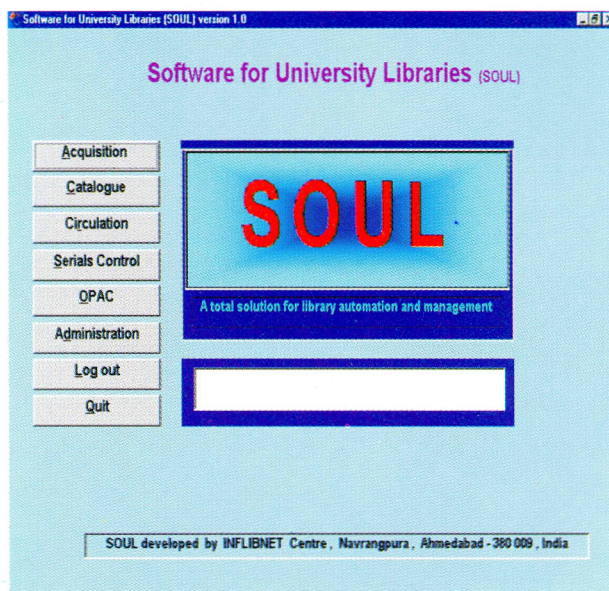

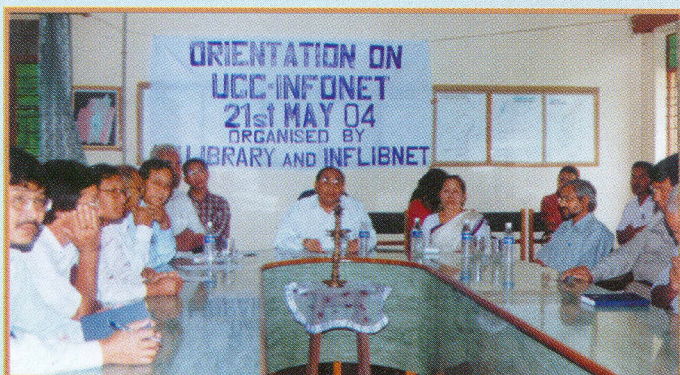

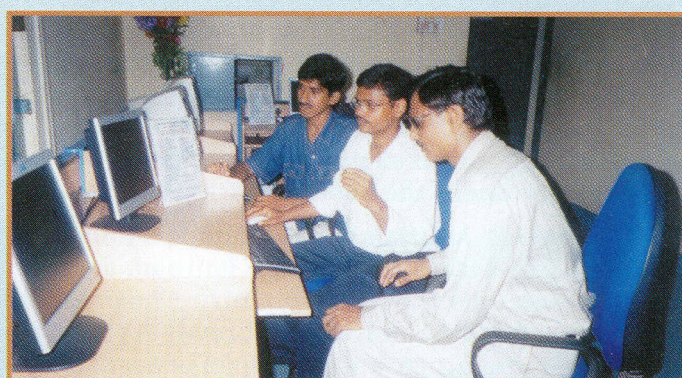
